- Middle and High School Student Ministries enjoyed a great winter camp in January with at least one student coming to faith
- Behind the scenes work on starting a "Marriage Mentoring" ministry that is on hold due to COVID
- Continuing Education for staff and elders on issues of abuse and racism

PARTICIPATORY WORSHIP

- Immediate transition in March to online worship services. In two weeks, we went from not having a meaningful online worship service to providing high-quality services on Facebook Live, YouTube, and SB-TV channel
 - Thank you to the volunteers and staff needed to make this happen
 - Both Sunday services and special services (Holy Week devotional services each day; Pentecost Threefold communion, etc)

- Tim Ramirez has become our worship leader for high school and college ministries, helping to mentor and train students, too
- Developing volunteer worship leaders and beginning the search for a new Pastor of Worship
- Student Sunday in the worship services
- Women's Ministry hosted "21 Days of Prayer" time in October – November





- Re-opening task force provided wise leadership
- Additional prayer opportunities, including:
 - Pastor Tim's Wednesday evening "40 Minutes of Prayer"
 - Women's Ministry's "21 Days of Prayer"
 - Devotional resources from the worship department

 Christmas Eve – 2019 was a wonderful year indoors, 2020 will (God-willing) be a great year outdoors!

FAITHFUL COMPASSION

- Churches Helping Churches Our church gave \$30,000 in grants to churches in the greater Long Beach area that are in more economically depressed communities that were struggling during COVID in a matching program with Kingdom Works, a Christian non-profit
- Caring Fund Helping people inside Grace and in the broader community. We also distributed some Caring Fund resources through partner Charis churches in harder hit socio-economic communities in southern California (Lancaster and Bellflower)
- High School and College Ministries have been involved with "Heart of the City Food Bank."
- Pentecost Threefold Communion Serving our compassion partners. This will be repeated at Thanksgiving Threefold in November.
- Continue to partner with great organizations including:
 - Precious Lamb Preschool
 - Long Beach Rescue Mission
 - Precious Life Shelter
 - Prison Fellowship
 - · Heart of the City Food Bank
 - World Relief
 - Horizon Pregnancy Clinic

This year we have given more to these organizations than budgeted in order to help them through COVID.

- Stephen Ministry Continued via Zoom during COVID and working to resume training of new Stephen Ministers.
- Calling of all Grace members by elders repeatedly during COVID.
- Hosted "GriefShare" class for those in bereavement.
- "College of Elders Prayer Night" brought together all current and former elders and their wives (if married) who are still at Grace in January for a time of prayer and updates.
- Our church continues to be a leader nationally and regionally in the Charis Fellowship.





MISSIONAL LIFE



- Announced the sending of Justin and Heidi Fox to plant Branches Church in Arcata, CA!
- Added two new long-term missionaries Evan Beard and the Burgess family. We continue to support 15 missionaries (individuals/families) around the world.
- One of our newer missionaries (Evan Warzybok, who grew up at Grace and now serves with Christian Challenge at Chico State) was married this year.
- Involved missionaries through Zoom in worship services and prayer gatherings
- College ministry partnering with Cru to start an outreach program at Cypress College.

- Jason Ricafranca regularly speaks at the Los Alamitos HS Bible club (prior to COVID).
- Middle School hosts "Operation Christmas Child" event.
- Supported Don Shoemaker in his role as chaplain with the Seal Beach Police Department.
- Eagle Commission (Military Chaplains) Our church ordained Dan Ruiz, Air Force chaplain
- We renovated the kitchen during COVID to help expand our "Christianity Explored" ministry.
- Project Mission Wish supporting and encouraging our missionaries this Christmas
